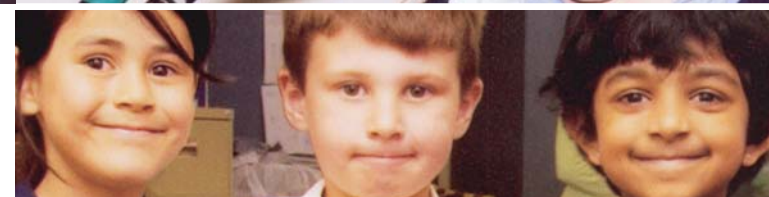

About PPN

The Bible, in the book of Timothy, says to pray for kings and all who are in authority. | Australia has a destiny as the Great South Land of the Holy Spirit. | We are a nation whose laws were founded on the laws of God.

In 1993, Peter and Lynne Klomp recognised the need for an organisation to pray for the leaders of our nation. They created the Parliamentary Prayer Network, an organisation that seeks to encourage effective prayer for all MPs, their families and their staff.

We take prayer requests from MPs and other sources and distribute them to our co-ordinators who then feed these requests into their prayer teams.

PPN co-ordinators come from all Christian denominations in every state and territory.

We have a national team now leading prayer groups in federal, state and territory parliaments.

Our model of prayer is easy, and adaptable enough to be used in other nations, and we are currently working to establish prayer in the parliaments of other nations.

We recognise the importance of linking with other prayer networks and the body of Christ. The PPN runs conferences in Parliament House and plays a leading role in co-ordinating prayer for state and federal elections.

Schools Programme

Our Schools Programme, developed by a qualified school teacher, is designed to train up a new generation of prayer warriors for our leaders. Each school adopts an MP to pray for and to build a relationship with.

Schools receive a number of items to help them on their exciting prayer adventure. These include a plaque and a photo of your MP with his or her profile, to display in your school. Activities include suggested prayers for weekly assemblies and two activities per year for a designated class to complete. We also send copies of books on government and Christian heritage.

PPN can also provide classes on visits to Parliament House. Where possible, we will involve Christian MPs to emphasise the Biblical perspective.

This is an exciting opportunity for your school to share and practise the Christian faith in a practical way. Prayer will change our nation. Our work is far from finished and we are looking for Christian schools to join with us in praying for our nation. *Will you pray in Jesus' name for our governments?*
